- When lifting up the tour bus, hold the front and back of the unit at the same time.
- Only use a dry cloth to clean the product. Never use a corrosive or abrasive substance to clean the product.

SAFE BATTERY USAGE

- Use alkaline batteries for best performance and longer life.
- Use only the battery type recommended for the unit.
- Batteries should be replaced only by an adult.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable batteries.
- · Do not short-circuit batteries.
- When not used for an extended time, remove batteries to prevent possible leakage and damage to the unit.
- Do not mix rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be recharged only under adult supervision.
- Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire as they may leak or explode.









Rotating driver's seat!




Rotate the door and driver's seat! When inserting the doll, lift up the steering wheel, buckle the seatbelt and then lower the steering wheel.

Before beginning, remove the pull tabs for the vanity and lights. Pull tabs are located on the battery compartment.









BATTERY REPLACEMENT

An adult must install fresh alkaline batteries in the unit should the batteries need replacing. Here's how:

- 1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw and battery compartment cover from under the rear bumper or the top of the lights.
- 2. Install three (3) 1.5V AG13 (LR44) alkaline batteries (not included) into either the vanity or the light, making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the screw.
