



TIPS FOR BUILDING THE SHOES

- Step 1. Make two piles: one for "R" items (right shoe) and one for "L" items.
- Steps 2 & 3. When assembling, align tabs with the corresponding holes on the
- Use a toothpick or tweezers to help push the tab into place. (Tweezers not included.) (Fig.1)
- Steps 4 & 5. Press firmly when applying stickers.
- Do not over handle or stretch the stickers when adhering them to the shoes.

TIPS FOR PREPARING THE SOLES

- . Step 6. Break apart the gel packs.
- Steps 7 & 8, Measure equal parts of gel A and B using the included mixing cup. (Fig. 2) Step 9. Mix gel for one minute until fully combined.
- Step 10. There is enough gel to fill both molds with some left over. Make sure to split
- evenly between the left and right sole. (Fig. 3) To evenly distribute the gel, carefully tilt the mold up and down for better coverage.
- DO NOT overfill the mold.
- Once your gel is poured into both sides of the mold, gently tap the mold to help remove any bubbles!
- Step 11. Press the shoes straight down into the gel until it covers the seam between the upper and the sole.
- Use the spatula or a damp napkin to remove any excess gel. (Napkin not included.) Steps 12 & 13. After 1 hour, loosen all sides of the mold and pull the shoes out.

- Trim excess gel from sole edges with scissors after the mold dries. (Scissors not included)

Note: Once finished, the shoe soles may appear a bit oily.

TIPS FOR LACING THE SHOES

Step 14. If needed, use a toothpick to slightly enlarge the holes before lacing the shoes. (Toothpick not included.)



PRO TIP



- Did you notice a gap in the soles after demolding? Here's how to fix it: Mix leftover A and B gel for one minute in the mixing cup.
- 2. Use the spatula or a toothpick to fill in any gaps.
- 3. Reinsert the sole into the mold, remove excess gel, and let it set for 1 hour.
- 4. Demold and trim any excess with scissors. (Scissors not included.)
